
## Plate Beat: L4 male Psyched For First Date



A C. elegans fourth larval-stage male has expressed excitement, along with some trepidation, about his first ever date to take place in ~8 hours. "I'm totally stoked!" said the XØ nematode, who is rapidly approaching the juvenile-to-adult transition. "Still, I don't want to seem over eager or desperate. That can really be a turn off to the ladies if you know what I mean", he added. "Still, I really do hope that all my tail rays morph in time", the blunt-tailed adolescent stated. When questioned about phenotypic preferences, the single-armed-gonad worm was emphatic about being "open to all types". "I mean, in my (plate) culture, we tend to have arranged matings.
